

The IES Vancouver Dixie Hudson Scholarship Program

The IES Vancouver Section is pleased to offer the Dixie Hudson Scholarship in awarding a \$2,000 Scholarship. This scholarship is available to dependents of personnel of current IES Vancouver Section members in good standing and to current student members of the IES. Students are not required to attend school in British Columbia, but must be attending or planning to attend an accredited college, university, or post secondary institute on a full time basis.

Please neatly fill in the application form, with the following attachments:

- 1. Verification of acceptance to the accredited college, university or post secondary education institute you plan to attend on a full time basis.
- 2. Field of study calendar excerpt and/or program brochure indicating tuition fee and content.
- 3. Your most current transcript.
- 4. An essay discussing your scholarship application, interest in your field of study, goals at school and graduation. Please type the essay, double spaced, no more that 2 pages.
- 5. Please provide two letters of recommendation; one letter of which should be from the applicant's teacher or employer/supervisor. Both letters should be addressing the applicant's overall character, class participation and academic potential.
- 6. Candidate may apply for IES Vancouver Dixie Hudson Scholarship once within a period of 5 years. If the candidate is applying a second time, applicant must show an upward change in their education program. For example, previous bachelor degree is elevated to Masters or previous Diploma elevated to Bachelor degree. The final decision will be determined by the IESBC Board in Vancouver.

Selection Criteria

The Vancouver Section of the IES will evaluate the applications according to the following criteria: Academic Performance, Community Involvement, Employment History, Field of Study, Essay Content.
