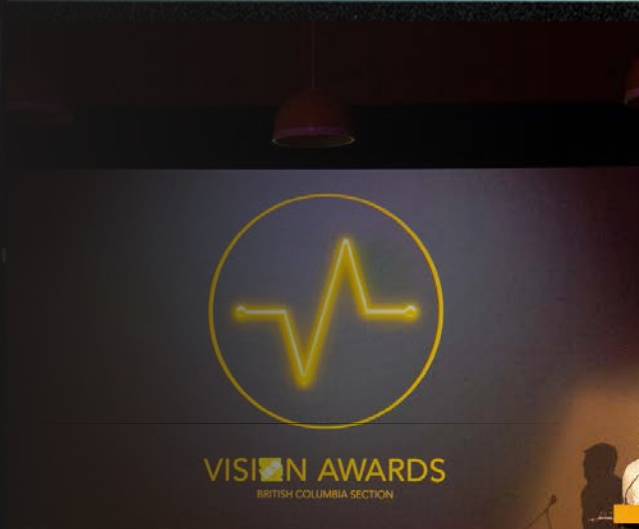

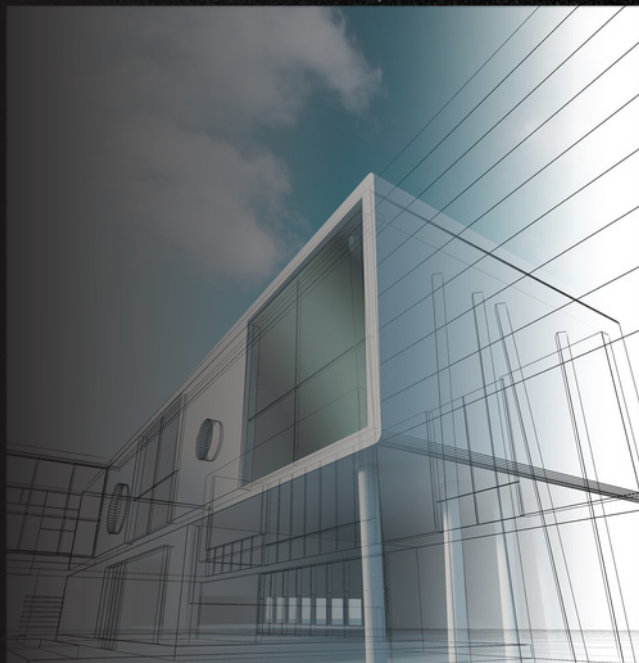

IAN ASHDOWN

Ian Ashdown's profound passion and dedication to lighting, unwavering commitment to scientific integrity, and remarkable expertise have left an indelible mark throughout his extraordinary career spanning over four decades. His contributions encompassed a wide range of academic papers (40+), technical articles (100+), lighting patents (136), and countless software developments. Without a doubt, Ian helped shape the lighting industry, and along the way, he inspired countless professionals around the world.

IAN ASHDOWN

An IES Fellow and member since 1993, Mr. Ashdown was a renowned distinguished individual who made significant contributions in the field of lighting design, research and development, standardization and software engineering, with interests in: horticultural lighting, daylight simulations and harvesting techniques, radiative flux transfer, colorimetry and radiometry, energy management systems for green buildings, illumination computer graphics and mesopic photometry. Beyond his renowned reputation as an engineer and scientist in the lighting field and beyond, Ian possessed a remarkable spirit of compassion. He selflessly assisted numerous individuals personally and professionally throughout their journeys. For his entire activity Ian was offered in 2017 the IES Medal, the society's highest recognition. Sadly, Ian Ashdown left us prematurely in June 2023, but his memory, contributions and legacy will live on.





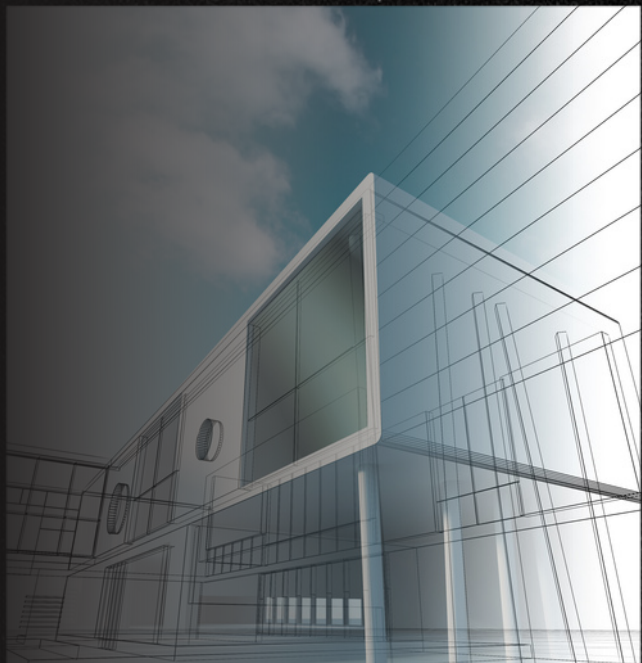
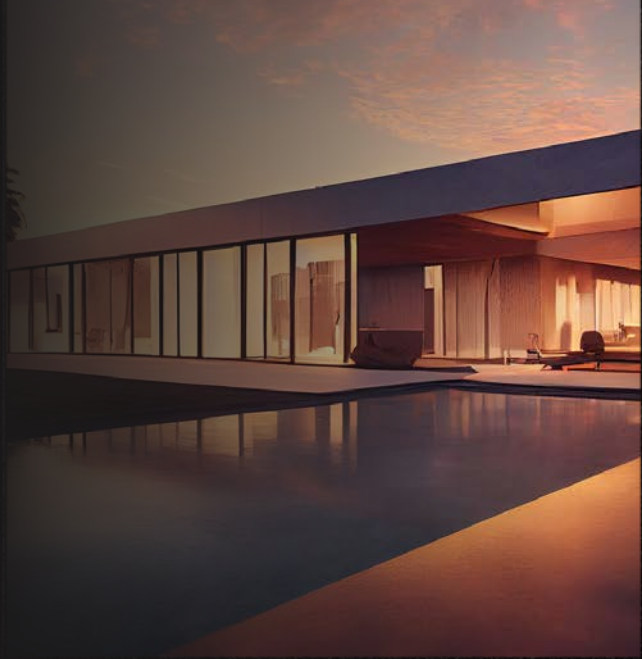

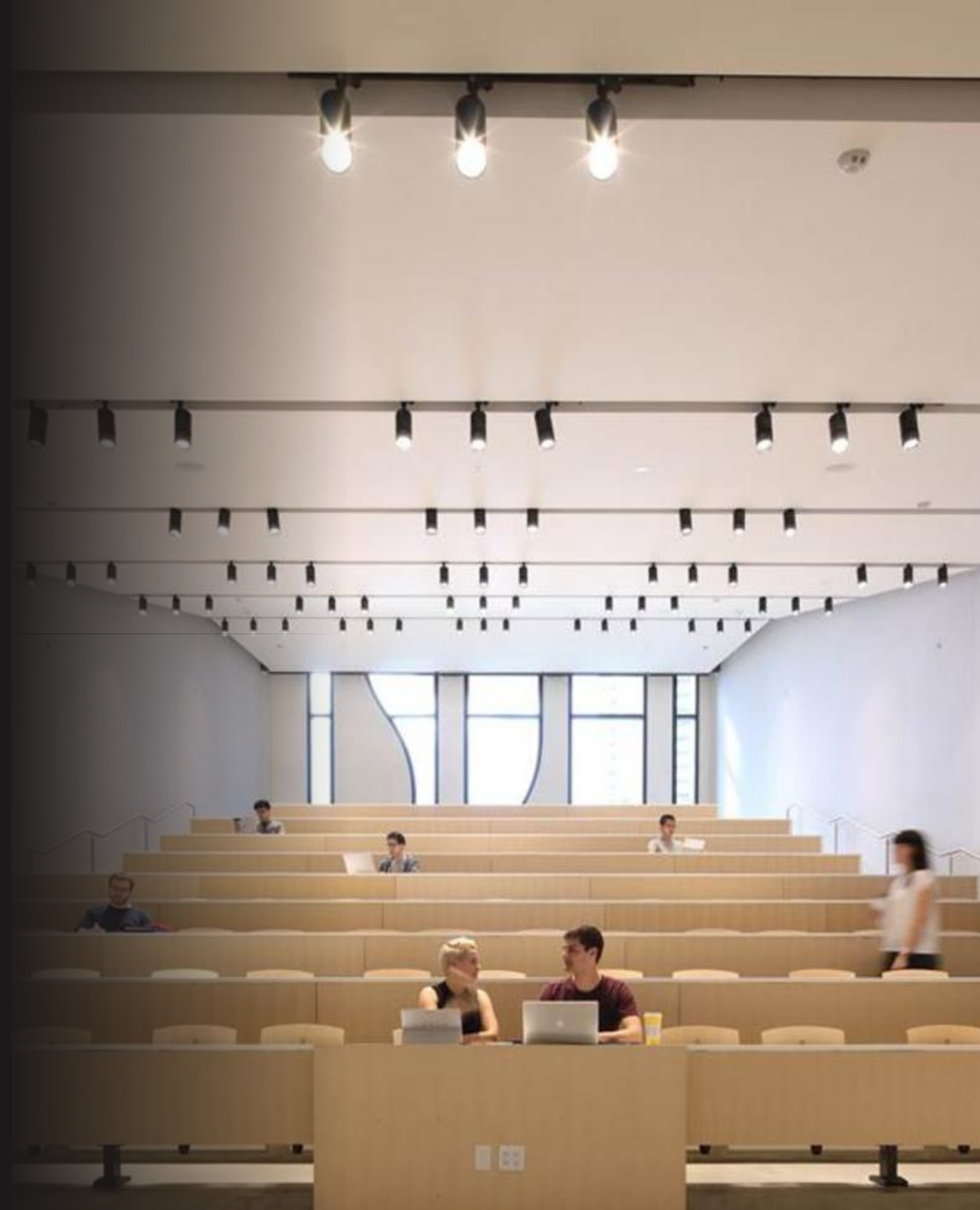
